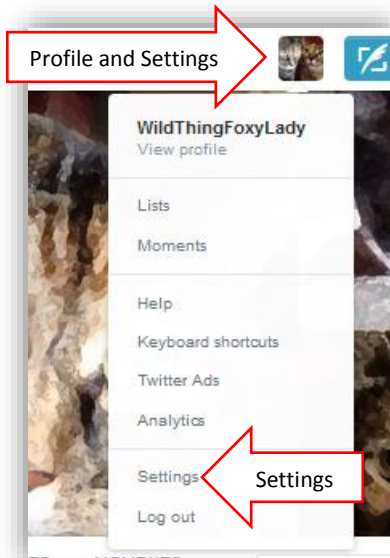


Embed a Twitter feed in a Basic Page.



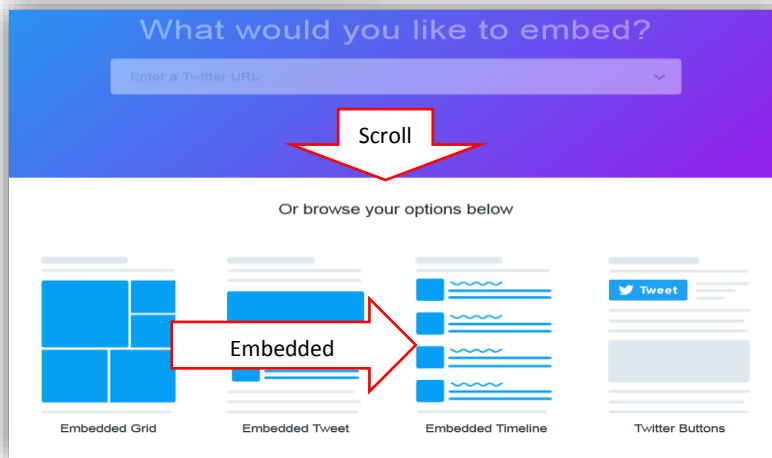
If you want to feature a Twitter feed on a Basic Page:

Log in to your Twitter account.

Select **Profile and Settings...Settings**.

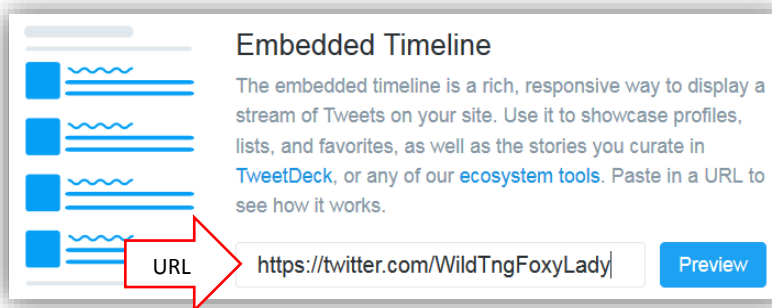
Select **Widgets...Create New**.

Select any of the **Widgets** on the list.



Scroll down to the **Or browse your options below** section.

Select the **Embedded Timeline** option.



Paste your **Twitter URL** into the URL box.

Select the **Preview** button.

Select **set customization options**.

Type in the pixel **Height** and **Width** you want for your embedded Twitter feed.

Note: the Basic Page is 600 pixels wide.

Select the background color, **Light or Dark**.

Select the **Link Color**.

Leave the language set to **Automatic**.

Select **Update** to save your settings.

Select the **Copy Code** button.

Create your Basic Page.

Insert the Embed Media Code where you want the Twitter feed to appear on your page. Paste the Twitter Embed Code you created into the Embed Media Dialog box and select OK. When you Save your page you will see the embedded Twitter feed.
